

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – February 27, 2019

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held February 27, 2019. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Porter, Michael Whitman, Brian Peters, Jack McIntyre, Edward Falconer, Drew Francisco and Catherine Wise. John Letzo Jr, arrived at 6:54.

Michael Whitman moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for February 28, 2019- General Fund \$73,234.53, State Fund - \$5,854.81, Cell Tower Escrow - \$8,441.29. James Glover seconded. Motion carried.

Brian Peters and Jack McIntre from the Mill Village Volunteer Fire Company discussed the EMS Paid Staffing, They spoke with the Supervisors concerning full assists, fire fighters, internal issues and the number of calls they have had. The Supervisors would like a quarterly report. They left at 6:40 p.m.

The Public Hearing for the Maintenance Ordinance will be held on March 13, 2019 at 8:00 a.m., preceding the Regularly Scheduled Meeting.

Road Foreman Report: Plowing Snow & Cindering. Discussed the 2019 Aprons. Drew would like to do both sides of Waite Road and Maybe North Dutchtown off of Route 6. They also discussed fixing Old Route 19, south end intersection. A windstorm blew a few trees down. The tar & chip bid will be advertised for opening on March 13, 2019. Troyer's Pit still has Anti-Skid to purchase for \$5.25, picked up. 1,000 tons will be ordered.

LeBoeuf Township will list 411's on the EAGOG request list and request that National Lime & Stone be notified of the bidding. There may be another source for brine. Tabled,
Drew will talk to Mill Village Borough and the cemetery association, about cutting the bank back and adding stones to the Cemetery side of Dutchtown Road South.

John Letzo Jr. from the MVVFC arrived at 6:54. He spoke with the Supervisors concerning critical calls and how the EMS program is working so far.

Correspondence was read and reviewed.

Secretary Report: The computer has been up dated. The 2018 audit has begun. The State Auditor will be performing the 2017 and 2018 Audits, A Microsoft Word/Excel program will be purchased for the Tax collector's computer.
