

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – July 10, 2019

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held July 10, 2019. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Porter, Michael Whitman, Ron Ethridge, J.R. Hanas, David Graham, Bill Cornwell, Drew Francisco and Catherine Wise.

Michael Whitman motioned to approve the minutes from the June 26, 2019 regular meeting. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for July 4, 2019- General Fund \$183,664.66, State Fund - \$35,901.13, Cell Tower Escrow - \$8,455.18. Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

Union LeBoeuf Road Resident David Graham spoke with the Supervisors about his neighbors setting off tannerite bombs, over the previous weekend. The Boom emitted from the blast rattled windows and knocked items off of walls. Supervisors stated that the resident will receive a letter informing him that according to the LeBoeuf Township Zoning Ordinance – vibrations are a violation.

Union LeBoeuf Road Resident Ron Etheridge was present to discuss the tar on the road. He feels that there is not sufficient coverage over the tar. It is getting on his tractor and car tires and leaving residue on his barn floor. The Supervisors will look into additional stone coverage.

Supervisors will ask Solicitor Chris Sennett to expedite the Mystic Road Gravel Pit sale, so that materials can be used as soon as possible.

In regards, to the amendment to the Zoning Ordinance: Supervisor Michael Whitman motioned to set “no acreage limit” required in the B1 zone under Campgrounds and RV parks and make it a SE “Special Exemption” on the District Use Table. Supervisor Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes. Supervisors discussed setting up a meeting with Mr. Jones and the adjoining land owners, to discuss the plan for the property.

The Supervisors reviewed a letter to be sent to the Mill Village Volunteer Fire Company asking for how many ambulance calls have been made so far this year vs. how many were calls were performed while the paid EMT personnel were on duty and the funds that have been generated.

Supervisors approved 2 checks to be re-issued due to being lost by employees.

Zoning Officer Bill Cornwell - John McGranor from Erie County Planning provided an definition for Rental Services. Supervisors would like rental of tents, kayaks, etc. added to it. A demo permit has been received for the Durci property on Route 19, it is slated to be completed by the end of July.

Road Foreman Report: Changed 5 cross-pipes. Performing base repair on Old Meadville. Worked on Old Route 19 South. Russell Standard reviewed what needs fixed on Old Meadville Road.

Corresponds was read & reviewed.

Insurance agents have been notified about receiving quotes for the year 2020.

Michael Porter motioned to ratify Bills & Payroll for July 4, 2019, Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Whitman moved, seconded by Michael Porter to adjourn the regular meeting at 8:56 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.
