

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – September 11, 2019

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held September 11, 2019. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Whitman, Michael Porter, Bill Manno, Mary & David Pulos, Ellery Troyer, George & Belinda Wilcox, Drew Francisco and Catherine Wise. Richard Wilkins arrived at 8:18 a.m.

Michael Whitman motioned to approve the minutes from the August 28, 2019 regular meeting. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter motioned to approve the minutes from the August 28, 2019 Public Hearing.

Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for September 12, 2019- General Fund \$187,929.49, State Fund - \$14,010.38, Cell Tower Escrow - \$8,465.83. Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

Dewey Road Property Owners were present to discuss the closing of Dewey Road. Supervisors stated that PennDot closed the bridge due to structure deficiencies.

Mr. Manno and Mr. Wilkins, who own property on the south section of Dewey Road from the Bridge to Stone Quarry Road, are in agreement to close their portion of the road. Mr. & Mrs. Wilcox, Mr. & Mrs. Pulos and Mr. Troyer were in agreement to keep the northern portion of Dewey Road from Wheelertown Road to the Bridge open, with LeBoeuf Township's continuation of maintenance. The residents informed Supervisors that there is still a lot of traffic on the north side of the road due to kayakers.

Discussion was held on placing multiple barriers across the Dewey Road Bridge to prohibit crossing of the bridge. Supervisor Porter suggested welding I-beams across the bridge and bolting Bridge Closed signs on the barrier. Other suggestions made were to place a large pile of gravel, a ditch and and/or barriers across the Southern section of Dewey Road at the intersection of Stone Quarry Road. The residents of Dewey Road left the meeting at 8:37 a.m.

The 2020 Minimum Municipal Obligation Worksheet was presented to the LeBoeuf Township Supervisors.

A letter was received from John Cooper - The Conneauttee Road Cell Tower is slated to be up and running in 2 to 3 weeks.

The Zoning Hearing Board held a Variance Hearing on Tuesday, September 10, 2019. They granted the request to Mr. Wislie on Flatts Road to construct a metal roof over his existing cottage.

Discussion was held on the "Campground" property on Route 19. Mr. Jones is working on Septic and DEP permits along with a plan to present to the LeBoeuf Township Planners.

Road Foreman Report: Moore Road will be opened today – September 11, 2019. The Tar & Chip project on Union LeBoeuf Road will be executed on September 12th or 13th. Graveling projects will be done on Holmes Road and Willey Road.

Drew Francisco gave an estimate of \$2,500.00 to fix the swale on Old Meadville Road.

Discussion was held on Ron Ethridge's tar problems.

Jack Merry requested millings for his driveway – Supervisors denied the request.

A letter will be sent to Mr. Matt Bennet on Old Meadville Road, asking to divert water on to his property.

Solicitor Chris Sennett sent information about the Mystic Road Gravel Pit purchase. Michael Porter motioned to agree to a down payment of \$3,000.00, Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes. All three Supervisors agreed that an inspection of the gravel pit is not necessary and to allow Solicitor Chris Sennett to work out the legal wording of the agreement with Attorney David Devine.

Correspondence and Permits were read & reviewed.

Michael Whitman motioned to sign Bills & Payroll for September 12, 2019, James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Whitman moved, seconded by James Glover to adjourn the regular meeting at 9:14 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.
