

## **LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – March 28, 2018**

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held March 28, 2018. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Porter, Michael Whitman, J.R. Hanas, Drew Francisco, Bill Cornwell, Cheryl Cornwell, Rex Ramey, David Hapeman and Catherine Wise.

James Glover motioned to approve the minutes from the March 14, 2018 regular meeting. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for March 29, 2018- General Fund \$58,300.62, State Fund - \$180,902.02, Cell Tower Escrow - \$8,442.34, Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

Crushing Bids: Girts Sand & Gravel: 3.78yd/37,800.00 - R.Hunter: 3.45 yd./34,500.00 – Ray Showman Jr.: 3.75yd/37,500.00 – Dwyer: 5.88 yd./58,800.00. Tabled.

Cheryl Cornwell stated that the school district does not pay for half of the Tax Collector Program that the tax collectors are currently using. She has tried the new program and it is helping her immensely. Michael Whitman motioned to purchase the program at a yearly fee of \$500.00, James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

The Storm-water Management and plans for Russell Standard's new Salt Storage Building were presented to the Supervisors. They would like to know what the cost would be for Engineer Mark Corey to review the plans and drawings. They would also like to meet with a representative from Russell Standard & Engineering firm Deiss & Halmi to discuss the plans.

Michael Whitman motioned to sign Resolution #3 of 2018 – LeBoeuf Township will join EAGOG – Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

The insurance agent submitted costs for Workman's Compensation Insurance for EMT employees. No action taken at this time.

A quote from Bush Insurance will be acquired for the Secretary Bond.

Road Foreman Report: Michael Porter gave the report: Scrap was hauled to Liberty Iron and cement blocks were purchased and transported back to the building. Built a bunk for storage of 411 materials behind municipal building. Green Distributors delivered pipe for projects. Both graders are ready to go. Did a little scuffing on Union LeBoeuf & Willey roads. Worked on equipment – report submitted.

Zoning Officer Bill Cornwell discussed an Amish resident on Smith Road who is having problems with the Erie County Health Department in regards to his septic and water.

Michael Porter reported that they are working on acquiring the brine tanks and information from DEP for the spreading of brine on roads.

Correspondence was read and reviewed.

Michael Whitman motioned to sign Bills & Payroll for March 29, 2018, Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter moved, seconded by Michael Whitman to adjourn at 7:08 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
