

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – April 25, 2018

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held April 25, 2018. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Whitman, Michael Porter, Drew Francisco, Bill Cornwell, Donald Hoover, Jessica Horan Kunco, and Catherine Wise.

Michael Whitman motioned to approve the minutes from the April 11, 2018 regular meeting. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for April 26, 2018- General Fund \$57,052.29, State Fund - \$161,748.17, Cell Tower Escrow - \$8,445.93, Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

Jessica Horan Kunco presented the Erie County COG Information and Quotes. She discussed Joint Bidding, membership, Liquid Fuels and PennDot approved materials, and Trainings. The Supervisors will need to appoint a Delegate and Alternative to attend meetings and vote on items.

Michael Whitman motioned to have Chairman James Glover sign the Russell Standard, Reimbursement Agreement for the Engineering review of Storm-water Management plan. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Whitman motioned to sign Resolution #4 of 2018 – the Hazard Mitigation Resolution, James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Whitman motioned to authorize Chairman James Glover to sign the E.L. Heard Fuel Agreement. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Donald Hoover was present to discuss his pending employment.

Road Foreman Report: Brine was discussed. Gravel Crushing will be done in May. The shop drains were cleaned out. A cross-pipe on Old Meadville road needs re-done for the Grant project. Dave's Welding is drafting arms for the new Rippers. Used Tractor Parts will reimburse for the cost.

Discussion was held on partnering with Mil Village Borough to pave a portion of Woods Road and to add aprons on Dutchtown road, with the cost to be split between the 2 municipalities. A cost quote will be obtained.

Zoning Officer Bill Cornwell discussed the loggers who are loading off the road. Supervisors will ask the Solicitor about Bonding Roads and what are the townships rights in enforcing the ordinance.

Correspondence was read and reviewed.

Michael Whitman motioned to sign Bills & Payroll for April 26, 2018, James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter moved, seconded by Michael Whitman to adjourn at 7:43 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
