

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – May 23, 2018

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held May 23, 2018. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Whitman, Michael Porter, Drew Francisco, Bill Cornwell, John McGranor, Dan Hawley, Ed Falconer, Frank Gocal, John Kurik and Catherine Wise.

James Glover motioned to approve the minutes from the May 9, 2018 regular meeting. Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for May 24, 2018- General Fund \$91,571.01, State Fund - \$152,945.05, Cell Tower Escrow - \$8,449.40, Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

John McGranor – Erie County Planning – Explained the Agricultural Security Area (ASA) Plan. This is a voluntary association for farmers and land owners in the area. An advisory board will need to be appointed if/when there is enough support to develop an ASA.

Mr. Frank Gocal was present to discuss Union LeBoeuf Road improvements that are currently being done. He was concerned about his driveway.

Ed Falconer discussed the Woods Road project. Supervisors had an idea to raise the road, to eliminate some of the erosion and pave it next year. The quote to pave it was approximately \$7,300.00. Discussion was also held on an apron for Dutchtown Road which is also shared by the township and borough.

Michael Porter motioned to install an apron on Dutchtown Road South and Route 6 this year, not to exceed \$9,000.00. Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes. The cost will be split with Mill Village Borough.

Dan Hawley from the Union City Volunteer Fire Department asked the Supervisors about the status of the Agreement between LeBoeuf Township and the contract with the Union City Volunteer Fire Department to provide EMT service. Supervisors explained that the township is looking into hiring EMT's to sit at the Mill Village Fire hall at this time, and will inform them at a later date of their decision.

In regards to No Parking Signs on Flatts Road by the Bridge: PennDot informed the Supervisors that they will not be responsible for No parking Signs along that road, but the township does have the authority to place and maintain them. The Supervisors in turn will send a letter to the resident who has requested them, that the township will install the signs, but the resident must purchase/replace and maintain the signs.

A letter will be sent to Waste Management voiding the contract for the Dumpster in November. An alternate company will then be used for garbage disposal.

A letter is to be sent to a resident on Stone Quarry Road, in which damage was done to the road in front of their house, by at least one vehicle after the road was graded.

Road Foreman Report: Discussion was held on State Millings availability and costs. Ditching has been done on Old Meadville and Frisbeetown Roads. The road crew is working on various roads – Grading, Mowing, Replacing Pipes, etc. The gravel has been crushed at the Mystic Road pit. Graveling will be done on Union LeBoeuf Road and Willey Road South.

John Kurik who lives on Union LeBoeuf Road was concerned about one of his driveways and his tree that was removed from the side of the road and placed in another location.

Zoning Officer – turned in 3 permits.

Correspondence was read and reviewed.

Michael Whitman motioned to sign Bills & Payroll for May 24, 2018, James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved, seconded by Michael Whitman to adjourn at 8:07 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
