

## **LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – June 13, 2018**

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held June 13, 2018. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Whitman, Drew Francisco, Walt McCray, J.R. Hanas, Ron Bennett, Ed Falconer, and Catherine Wise.

Michael Whitman motioned to approve the minutes from the May 23, 2018 regular meeting. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for June 7, 2018- General Fund \$90,411.96, State Fund - \$147,348.32, Cell Tower Escrow - \$8,449.40, Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

Mr. Walt McCray – Union LeBoeuf Road – Discussed an issue with water running onto his property. He would like the ditch lowered 12 more inches, totaling 4 feet. Supervisor – Road Master- Michael Porter previously spoke with Mr. McCray and had stated that he will look at the situation. Mr. McCray also requested that the township replaces a drainage pipe on his property. He was informed that the township does not replace pipes on private property. Discussion was also held on Manufactured Brine. Mr. McCray left at 8:23 a.m.

Mr. Ron Bennett spoke with the Supervisors and Road Foreman concerning his yard on Old Route 19. The Township's Road Crew will be performing shoulder work on Old Route 19. He requested that they do not strip the section of his yard south of his driveway. Road Foreman- Drew Francisco will take a look at it and discuss a plan with Mr. Bennett.

Ed Falconer informed the Supervisors that Mill Village Borough Council would like to pay for the Blacktop extension on Woods Road, in exchange for LeBoeuf Township paying for the apron on Dutchtown Road South. Mill Village Borough Council is also in agreement to pay any difference in the projects to keep the cost even for both municipalities. This is due to Mill Village Borough Council wanting the Woods Road project completed this year. Tabled.

Brine was discussed. Representative Curt Sonney's office was called to ask what the fine would be if brine was spread on township roads, they did not have a definitive answer. Tabled.

Hiring of EMT – Tabled.

The DEP Permit for Russell Standard's Salt Pad was approved. Engineer Mark Corey approved the Russell Standard Salt Storage - Storm Water Management Plan.

Road Foreman Report: The Grant Application for Old Meadville Road was submitted. Road work has been done on Smedley Road. Graveling on Union LeBoeuf Road. Mowing is being done and a company has been hired for trimming of trees. A driveway pipe was completed on Stone Quarry Road. The John Deere Grader needed fixed. Drew requested that PennDot Municipal Services Representative - Josh Montgomery be contacted to ask about trading services for the Agility Program.

James Glover motioned to sign the Camphire Subdivision (Revised Plans), Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes.

Correspondence was read and reviewed.

James Glover motioned to ratify Bills & Payroll for June 7, 2018, Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Whitman moved, seconded by James Glover to adjourn at 9:35 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.
