

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – June 27, 2018

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held June 27, 2018. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Whitman, Drew Francisco, Ed Falconer, Bill Cornwell, County Councilman Scott Rastetter and Catherine Wise.

Michael Whitman motioned to approve the minutes from the May 23, 2018 regular meeting. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for June 21, 2018- General Fund \$118,390.73, State Fund - \$140,992.06, Cell Tower Escrow - \$8,452.99, Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

County Councilman Scott Rastetter attended the meeting to introduce himself and to meet the Supervisors and Staff. He wanted to know how County Council can help the Township. It was stated that funding for improvements to roads was the main concern for LeBoeuf Township.

Ed Falconer informed the Supervisors that Mill Village Borough Council would like to pay for the Blacktop extension on Woods Road, in exchange for LeBoeuf Township paying for the apron on Dutchtown Road South. Mill Village Borough Council is also in agreement to pay any difference in the projects to keep the cost even for both municipalities. This is due to Mill Village Borough Council wanting the Woods Road project completed this year. Tabled.

PennDot sent the Ordinance, Agreement, etc. for the Moore Road Bridge Project. Supervisors requested that Mr. Thomas Alcorn –The Local Bridge Contract Manager – attend the next Supervisor Meeting to explain the submitted paperwork.

Road Foreman Report: Graveling has been completed on Willey South. The road crew is working on the joint project on Smedley Road with Washington Township.

In regards to the Old Meadville Grant project. Municipal Services representative Josh Montgomery will provide the advertisement for tar & chip, and Tom McClure from the Conservation district will approve it, before the township submits it to the newspaper. Bids are to be received by the township for opening, at the July 25, 2018 meeting.

Russell Standard Corp. will fix Union LeBoeuf Road – the MC-70 is failing. Tar is bleeding up through the road. It is under warranty.

Discussion was held on plowing French Creek Road this winter, for PennDot, as part of the Agility Program. This is pending approval by PennDOT's Union. Michael Whitman motioned to agree to plow French Creek road. James Glover abstained. Motion died for lack of second.

Tabled.

Road Foreman Drew Francisco would like to use his own cell phone and turn the township cell phone off. Michael Whitman motioned to pay the Road Foreman – Drew Francisco - \$30.00 per month for use of his personal cell phone. James Glover seconded, all voted yes. The township cell will be turned off.

The Brine Tank has been ordered. Quotes were received from Seneca Mineral for State Approved brine. Discussion was held on different ideas for dust control.

Resident Milo Hull requested that the township change the zoning on a strip of Route 19 North to allow him to erect a Billboard. On advice from Erie County Planning – the township cannot zone one side of the road Residential and the other side B-1/Commercial, this is considered strip zoning.

A pension audit will be performed on July 3, 2018 and the New Zoning Ordinance public hearing and adoption and signing of ordinance will be advertised for the July 25, 2018 meeting night.

Zoning Officer Bill Cornwell reported that he is working on getting Logging Permits from Loggers on Gourley Road, Frisbeetown Road and Route 97/Hare Road.

Correspondence was read and reviewed.

James Glover motioned to ratify Bills & Payroll for June 21, 2018, Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved, seconded by Michael Whitman to adjourn at 7:53 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
