

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – July 11, 2018

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held July 11, 2018. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Whitman, Michael Porter, Drew Francisco, Bill Cornwell, Tom Alcorn, Tom McClure, Pat Casher, J.R. Hanas, Ed Falconer and Catherine Wise.

Michael Whitman motioned to approve the minutes from the May 23, 2018 regular meeting. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for July 5, 2018- General Fund \$118,390.73, State Fund - \$140,992.06, Cell Tower Escrow - \$8,452.99, Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

Resident Pat Casher was present to inform Supervisors about a property for sale on Route 19 that is unlivable and in disrepair. He stated that there is garbage in the yard, with vermin. It is a Health and Fire hazard. Supervisors stated that we do not have an ordinance at this time, but they are looking into enacting a Property Maintenance or Nuisance ordinance in the future.

Mike Oberlander from Waterford Paving Co. submitted a Quote for the apron on Dutchtown Road for \$5,176.00. Michael Porter motioned to accept the Waterford Paving quote, Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes.

Discussion was held on the EMT Agreement; Ed Falconer stated, that in his opinion, Rockdale Township will not be signing a contract with the Mill Village Volunteer Fire Department. Solicitor Chris Sennett is corresponding with Rockdale's Solicitor in regards to their decision. Tabled.

Mr. Thomas Alcorn –The Local Bridge Contract Manager from PennDot – attended the Supervisor's Meeting to explain the submitted paperwork and ordinance for the Moore Road Bridge Project. The Supervisors voted to advertise the Public Hearing meeting to be scheduled for July 25, 2018 at 5:45 p.m. The ordinance is scheduled to be signed following the Hearing at their regularly scheduled meeting. Mr. Alcorn left at 8:45.

Mr. Tom McClure from the Erie Conservation District was present to submit the bidding forms to be advertised for opening at the July 25th meeting – The bids are for Bituminous Seal Coat for the Old Meadville Grant Project. Michael Porter motioned to authorize Chairman James Glover as the official to sign any and all paperwork in regards to the Grant Project. Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes. Mr. McClure left at 8:55.

J.R. Hanas discussed the Hanas Gravel pit, he would like to keep 1 acre open and close the rest of the pit.

Discussion was held again on plowing French Creek Road for the winter of 2018/2019, as part of PennDOT's Agility Program. This is pending approval by PennDOT's Union. Michael Whitman motioned to agree to plow French Creek road. Michael Porter seconded. Michael Porter and Michael Whitman both voted yes. James Glover abstained. Motion carried.

Road Foreman Report: The Brine tank will be delivered July 11, 2018. It was agreed to try using Dawn Dishwashing Liquid on Township roads to attempt to control the dust. The water pump on the mower tractor is being fixed by Scott Johnson. The Air Conditioner on the Mack truck needs repaired. Anti-skid has been hauled for Washington Township in exchange for road work on Old Route 19. The bank on Hare Road at the intersection of Route 97 was cut down for visibility and seeded.

Road Foreman Drew Francisco received a 6 month review. Michael Whitman motioned to set his wages at \$21.00 per hour, starting July 15, 2018. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes. Employee Chris Truitt received his 90 day review. Michael Whitman motioned to set his pay at \$18.00 per hour, starting July 15, 2018. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Zoning Officer Bill Cornwell reported logging permits have been issued. The Cell Tower Permit will need renewed in August. Building Inspector Mike Grill will be asked again to attend a Supervisors meeting, due to a cancellation earlier in the year, because of a snowstorm.

Correspondence was read and reviewed.

James Glover motioned to ratify Bills & Payroll for July 5, 2018, Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Whitman moved, seconded by Michael Porter to adjourn at 10:00 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.
