

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – January 23, 2019

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held January 23, 2019. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Porter, Michael Whitman, Harold “Red” Campbell, Bill Cornwell, Solicitor Chris Sennett, Edward Falconer, Drew Francisco and Catherine Wise.

The Minutes from the Re-Organizational Meeting, Public Hearing and Supervisor’s Meeting from January 7, 2019 were tabled until the next meeting.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer’s Report for January 17, 2019- General Fund \$74,006.86, State Fund - \$28,927.22, Cell Tower Escrow - \$8,437.71, Line of Credit Account - \$57,675.57 remaining. Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

Public Comment: Harold “Red” Campbell was present to discuss Holmes Road. He stated that the road needs graded, ditched and graveled properly this Spring.

Road Foreman Report: Plowing Snow. The Equipment Report was presented. The Tri-Axle has been fixed. A 2 ft. bucket was purchased at an online auction for the John Deere Backhoe. The old generator was sold on Municibid for \$580.00. A quote will be acquired from Seneca Mineral for Brine. Discussion was held on bidding tar & chip for Old Meadville and Union LeBoeuf Roads for 2019. Josh Montgomery – PennDot Municipal Services will be contacted to construct the bid for the newspaper. Michael Porter motioned to bid tar & chip for up to 3 miles of road (total length to be determined by the Road Foreman). Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes. Motion Carried. Discussion was also held on purchasing a used tandem dump truck currently in Illinois.

The Supervisors and Solicitor Chris Sennett discussed the current hiring practices of the Mill Village Volunteer Fire Company’s EMT personnel. They can have 10 to 12 people, but it should not extend to over 20 people. Supervisors stated that the contract reads: The township will pay for EMT’s only, not for Fire Services. They feel that EMT’s should not be sent out on Fire Calls in a Firefighter capacity while on the clock as an EMT.

James Glover motioned to appoint Jeffery Malinowski as Auditor for 2019, Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Whitman motioned to accept the resignation of Cheryl Cornwell as the LeBoeuf Township Tax Collector, Michael Porter seconded. A Special Meeting will be advertised for Wednesday, January 30, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. to appoint a new Tax Collector for 2019. The position will be placed on the Ballot for Election.

The Sewage Violation letter from Erie County Health Department was reviewed.
The Building – Gutter Quote from Sharpe Construction was tabled until other quotes can be acquired.

Zoning Officer Bill Cornwell brought up the subject of the Cell Tower on Conneauttee Road. They have not begun construction as of this date. Their permit was renewed in August. They will be contacted to ask about their intentions on this project. Bill also received permission to install additional LED Light Bulbs in the Building.

Correspondence was read and reviewed.

James Glover motioned to ratify Bills & Payroll for January 17, 2019, Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter moved, seconded by Michael Whitman to adjourn the regular meeting at 7:18 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
