

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – April 24, 2019

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held April 24, 2019. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Porter, Michael Whitman, Mike Wise, Edward Falconer, Drew Francisco and Catherine Wise. Bill Cornwell arrived at 6:25 p.m.

James Glover motioned to approve the minutes from the April 10, 2019 regular meeting. Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for April 25, 2019- General Fund \$114,864.80, State Fund - \$146,558.38, Cell Tower Escrow - \$8,448.12. Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

Public Comment – Mike Wise complained about a letter he received from Zoning Officer Bill Cornwell stating that he was in violation of 2 ordinances. He agreed that he would apply for the Demolition Permit requested, but it was the Loggers Responsibility to apply for the Logging Permit and he had given the Zoning Officer the information. He would prefer phone calls to letters in the future. Mr. Wise left at 6:15 p.m. Zoning Officer Bill Cornwell arrived after Mr. Wise's departure and explained that he was not able to get the Forester and Logger to apply for the permit, so he sent the letter to the land owner.

Edward Falconer requested that Drew Francisco be named as Emergency Management Assistant. Michael Porter motioned to appoint Drew Francisco as the Emergency Management Assistant, James Glover seconded. All voted yes. A new Erie County 911 radio will be installed in the township pick-up truck and Ed & Drew will be attending training sessions in regards to the new radio system.

Road Foreman Report: The Equipment Report was submitted. Discussion was held on selling the Oshkosh Truck. It will be placed on Muncibid with a minimum request of \$7,500.00. The crew is grading roads and fixing shoulders. A pipe on Waterhouse Road needs replaced. Two quotes were received for the replacement of the pipe: Edward Musgrave: \$3,800.00. Ray Showman Jr.: \$4,900.00. Mayer Brothers were asked for a quote, but it has not been received as of this date. Tabled.

Municipal Services Rep – Josh Montgomery - will be called about requirements for Asphalt Approaches.

Supervisors are investigating State & PennDot Laws concerning the purchase and use of the Mystic Road Gravel Pit. They received a letter and a Municipal Exemption Form from Arnold Belz – *Department of Environmental Protection-Surface Mine Inspector Supervisor-DEP Mining Operations*. Mr. Belz stated: Municipalities using a gravel pit for their own use is noncommercial and does not require a permit. The sale of the Mystic Road Gravel pit was tabled until more information can be obtained from the Western Conservancy.

Correspondence was read and reviewed.

Zoning Officer Report: A permit was issued for a new trailer on Stone Quarry Road.

Michael Whitman motioned to sign Bills & Payroll for April 25, 2019, Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Whitman moved, seconded by James Glover to adjourn the regular meeting at 7:00 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
