

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – May 8, 2019

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held May 8, 2019. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Porter, Michael Whitman, Walt McCray Josh Montgomery, Bill Cornwell, Drew Francisco and Catherine Wise.

James Glover motioned to approve the minutes from the April 24, 2019 regular meeting. Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for May 9, 2019- General Fund \$120,639.25, State Fund - \$134,156.61, Cell Tower Escrow - \$8,451.59. Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

Public Comment – Walt McCray – Union LeBoeuf Road – spoke with the Supervisors and Road Foreman about changing the sluice pipe and the re-routing of the water in the ditch, in front of his property. Supervisors will check on the direction of water flow within the ditch. Supervisor Michael Porter noted that in the future, drainage from Township Roadways has to be approved by the Road Master.

The CDBG Fund application was presented. No one from the township will attend the ECATO Yearbook dinner.

Municipal Services Representative – Josh Montgomery was present to discuss the purchase of the Mystic Road Gravel pit – he stated that the township can use the gravel on township roads and Liquid Fuels monies can be used for hiring of the crushing of the gravel. Mr. Montgomery suggested that the township also contact MSHA (Mine Safety and Health Administration) about the gravel pit.

Josh informed the Supervisors about asphalt approaches: According to the Township Code Book, materials must be PennDot Approved. PennDot specifications,(unless paid for by General Funds) suggest using a 10 ton roller, acquiring 3 quotes for all work and installing a 50-100 foot apron. A project number is needed for anything with 1 inch or more of asphalt.

In regards to the purchase of the gravel pit and who owns the gravel under a road, Solicitor Chris Sennett will be called for information.

Road Foreman Report: The Equipment Report was submitted. Grading roads. Brine was placed on Stone Quarry Road and Middleton Road. A cross-pipe was installed on Waterhouse Road. The Road Foreman will be meeting with Russell Standard on Old Meadville Road, to discuss the failure of materials.

Discussion was held on PennDot Auctions and other auctions – the Township is looking for a New Truck to use for Plowing and Hauling Gravel.

Zoning Officer Report: There will be a variance hearing on Tuesday, May 14, 2019 for Easton Ray on Union LeBoeuf Road – to build a pole barn, 15 foot from the property line. There is a For Sale Sign on the Property owned by Vertical Bridge – the Cell Tower location. They will be asked to attend a meeting to discuss their progress and what their plans are for the property. The Zoning Officer will be out of town for 2 weeks, beginning May 13, 2019.

Secretary Catherine Wise gave a report on the Knox Law Symposium. Correspondence was read and reviewed.

James Glover motioned to sign Bills & Payroll for May 9, 2019, Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter moved, seconded by James Glover to adjourn the regular meeting at 9:10 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.
