

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – May 22, 2019

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held May 22, 2019. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Porter, Michael Whitman, Jim & Trina McGuire, Brian Jones, Drew Francisco and Catherine Wise. Dave Wilkins arrived at 6:25 p.m.

Michael Whitman motioned to approve the minutes with corrections from the May 8, 2019 regular meeting. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for May 23, 2019- General Fund \$150,198.77, State Fund - \$120,928.75, Cell Tower Escrow - \$8,451.59. Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

Public Comment – Jim & Trina McGuire were present to discuss the Camp Grounds which is being built near their home on Route 19. They presented passages from the LeBoeuf Township Zoning Ordinance, showing why a camp ground cannot be placed within the B-1 Zone. Mr. Brian Jones – the owner/builder of the property was present to explain exactly what he is doing with the property and what his future plans are. He has begun building cabins on the property and has plans for additional cabins, a bath house, a store front, RV lots and kayak rentals. Supervisors asked him to submit a formal plan and Zoning Officer Bill Cornwell will be asked about permits, which have not been issued yet. Mr. Wilkins lives next door to the property in question. He did not have a comment at this time.

Michael Porter motioned to allow Raccoon Refuse, a 2 month trial period, to set up a Saturday – Recycling Day Drop Off - in the LeBoeuf Township Parking Lot. Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes.

Supervisors discussed having the Solicitor perform Title Searches for the Mystic Road Property. They responded to the Western Conservancy questions concerning the Mystic Road property and the mining of the road. They also discussed acquiring a Survey of the property. The Supervisors are in agreement to have Solicitor Chris Sennett draw up agreements for all parties concerned in the near future. Tabled.

Road Foreman Report: The Equipment Report was submitted. Grading and Brining various roads. The Backhoe needs a new Rim. Russell Standard is willing to warranty the tar & chip on Old Meadville Road. Drew will be traveling to Harrisburg, to look at trucks being auctioned off by PennDot. The Oshkosh did not sell on Municibid. It will be re-advertised at a starting bid of \$5,000.00. An ad may be placed in the Area Shopper also.

Permits & Correspondence were read and reviewed.

Michael Whitman motioned to sign Bills & Payroll for May 23, 2019, James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter moved, seconded by Michael Whitman to adjourn the regular meeting at 7:28 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
