

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – August 28, 2019

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held August 28, 2019. The meeting was called to order at 6:27 p.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Whitman, Michael Porter, Larry Hanas II, Robert Rindfuss, Bob & Jayne Rindfuss, James Warner, Steve Shallenberger, Jim McGuire, Ed Falconer, Bill Cornwell, Drew Francisco and Catherine Wise. John Letzo Jr. arrived at 6:50 p.m.

Michael Whitman motioned to approve the minutes from the August 14, 2019 regular meeting. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for August 29, 2019- General Fund \$156,822.95, State Fund - \$18,331.89, Cell Tower Escrow - \$8,462.24. Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors agreed to table the Zoning Ordinance Revisions Proposed, until a plan can be submitted to the Board of Planners and a recommendation made by the Board of Planners on how to proceed. Michael Porter stated that in the future before the Supervisors change anything they will meet and co-ordinate with the Board of Planners.

Edward Falconer: Informed the Supervisors that the Bridge on Route 19 in Waterford Township is slated to be closed in April of the year 2020. This will detour traffic onto Flatts Road and into Mill Village Borough.

Solicitor Chris Sennett and Attorney David Devine are working on the contract for the Mystic Road Gravel pit.

Supervisor Michael Whitman motioned to appoint Steve Shallenberger to the open position on the LeBoeuf Township Board of Planners. Supervisor Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

The Supervisors denied the request from Veronica Grimm to pay for repairs to her vehicle. There is no evidence or witnesses that it occurred on Old Meadville Road and they do not want to set precedence in regards to vehicle repairs.

John Letzo Jr. from the Mill Village Volunteer Fire Company explained to the Supervisors the increase in call volumes and the funds being generated by the Ambulance. He also stated that a new ambulance may be needed in the near future. It was agreed to have a meeting between the Fire Department, Borough Council Members and Township Supervisors in November to review the first year of the agreement for Paid Staffing.

James Warner, Larry Hanas II, Steve Shallenberger and Robert, Bob & Jayne Rindfuss all left the meeting at 7:20 p.m.

Road Foreman Report: Pulling Sods on Moore Road and placed gravel on the road.

The Tar & Chip project on Union LeBoeuf road is slated for September 12, 2019.

A part-time CDL truck driver is needed. The road crew will be graveling Holmes Road.

Supervisor Porter stated that he went to Mr. Etheridge's house on Union LeBoeuf Road and that the tar is a concern and needs to be covered as soon as possible. He also suggested letting the Conservation District know when there is a problem with the roads that have received grants. Road Foreman Drew Francisco has been keeping them up to date on failures. Discussion was held on 35 mph speed limits on roads.

Zoning Officer Bill Cornwell: Presented 2 demo permits. He also asked about the cell tower completion on Conneauttee Road. John Cooper will be contacted to ask when it will be completed.

Correspondence and Permits were read & reviewed.

Coverage for Health Insurance was discussed.

Letters will be sent to land owners on Dewey Road, requesting their presence at a meeting to discuss closing Dewey Road.

Michael Whitman motioned to sign Bills & Payroll for August 29, 2019, James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Whitman moved, seconded by Michael Porter to adjourn the regular meeting at 7:48 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
