

## **LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – September 25, 2019**

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held September 25, 2019. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Whitman, Michael Porter, Bill Cornwell, Drew Francisco and Catherine Wise.

James Glover motioned to approve the minutes from the September 11, 2019 regular meeting. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for September 26, 2019- General Fund \$188,960.17, State Fund - \$5,022.68, Cell Tower Escrow - \$8,465.83. Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

Solicitor Chris Sennett and Attorney David Devine are still working on the contract for the Mystic Road Gravel pit.

The Small Flow Septic System report was reviewed.

Discussion was held on the Budget and the depletion of the State Fund Account.

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors agreed to place all the current ordinances in a 3 ring binder.

Road Foreman Report: The Tar & Chip project on Union LeBoeuf Road is complete. The invoice was received and additional quantities were added. They will be called to justify the additional expense. Willey Road has been graveled. Matt Bennett on Old Meadville Road has agreed to have road drainage diverted onto his property. A meeting will be set up to discuss the details and agreement. Discussion was held on the closing of Dewey Road from the Bridge to Stone Quarry - Guard Rails may be installed to keep vehicles from going around the barrier at the end of the road.

Zoning Officer Report: An Occupancy Permit was received from CCI Inspections, for the Cell Tower on Conneauttee Road. It was discussed to inform John Cooper that the Mill Village Volunteer Fire Company will need a key to the gate at the Cell Tower in the event of a fire or emergency. Sheds are being placed at Kandy's a permit will be acquired.

Correspondence and Permits were read & reviewed.

James Glover motioned to sign Bills & Payroll for September 26, 2019, Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter moved, seconded by Michael Whitman to adjourn the regular meeting at 6:55 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
