

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – February 12, 2020

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held February 12, 2020. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Whitman, Bill Cornwell, Drew Francisco, Denny Triscuit and Catherine Wise. Russell Standard Representative: Mike Rowe, Nathan Waldenville and Nathan Hunt arrived at 8:30 a.m.

Michael Whitman motioned to approve the minutes from the January 22, 2020 Regular Meeting, James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for February 13, 2020 - General Fund \$38,464.77 and State Fund - \$2,083.81, Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

Union Township Supervisor Denny Triscuit attended the meeting to discuss the Union City Ambulance Service. He is in favor of developing a South County Ambulance Service, which would incorporate Union City, Wattsburg, Mill Village and other Ambulance services in the area. Discussion was also held on how to pay for the Ambulance Services – Billing and taxes.

Representatives from Russell Standard were in the area, to review Union LeBoeuf Road, in regards to the failure of the tar and chip. The tar is running off the road and the stone is not sticking to the road. The road will not be able to be repaired until the spring/summer season.

Drew Francisco and Catherine Wise attended a Workshop on Grants. Supervisors agreed to apply for County Aid monies, to be used towards the cost of Brine.

Road Foreman Report: Drew presented a quote for the placement of 1 mile of crushed and placed millings with an asphalt surface for a cost of \$299,000.00 plus, from Lindy Paving. The Road crew has been Hauling Millings, Plowing snow and cleaning ditches. PennDOT has millings for sale at \$5.00 per ton. – Tabled.

Zoning Officer William Cornwell reported that Mike Leslie is logging for Jeff Malinowski on Woods Road. A logging permit is needed on Union LeBoeuf Road – Shetlers will be notified.

James Glover motioned to ratify Bills & Payroll for January 30, 2020, Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover motioned to sign Bills & Payroll for February 13, 2020, Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Whitman moved, seconded by James Glover to adjourn the regular meeting at 9:25 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.
