

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – February 26, 2020

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held February 26, 2020. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Whitman, Bill Cornwell, Drew Francisco, Edward Falconer, Tim Pietrasewicz and Catherine Wise.

Michael Whitman motioned to approve the minutes from the February 12, 2020 Regular Meeting, James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for February 27, 2020 - General Fund \$27,255.42 and State Fund - \$5,083.81, Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

Tim Pietrasewicz discussed his land dispute with his neighbors. He is waiting for a court date. Mr. Pietrasewicz asked if there was anything else that the township could provide in regards to this matter. The Supervisors stated that they do not have anything at this time for his civil case.

Edward Falconer – President of the Mill Village Cemetery Association stated that the members may be in agreement to cut the bank on Dutchtown Road and apply a ground cover. Tabled.

Gravel Crushing Bids came in as follows:

R. Hunter - \$3.44 per yard (\$34,400.00), Wilkinson - \$3.40 per yard (\$34,000.00), Ray Showman Jr. - \$3.90 per yard (39,000.00) and Dwyer - \$4.50 per yard (45,000.00).

Michael Whitman motioned to accept the Bid to crush 10,000 yards of gravel from Wilkinson at \$3.40 per yard for a total cost of \$34,000.00. James Glover seconded. All voted yes. Motion carried.

An EMS meeting will be held at the American Legion in Union City on March 5, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. Supervisors were invited to attend to discuss the future of Ambulance Services in the area. Michael Whitman stated that he will attend. The Supervisors declined attending the ECATO March Schools.

Road Foreman Report: Grading was done on a few roads. Six to Eight loads of #3 stone was placed on Whitley Road due to a blow out of the road. 1,000 tons of Agility Millings have been hauled to the Glover Gravel Pit. Discussion was held on the application of millings on roads. LeBoeuf Township would like to enter into an agreement with Mill Village to place millings on Dutchtown Road from Route 6 to Woods Road.

Michael Whitman motioned to purchase an additional \$7,500.00 worth of Millings from PennDOT at a maximum of \$5.00 per ton with a 10% loading charge. James Glover seconded. All voted yes. Motion Carried.

Zoning Officer William Cornwell reported that Logging permits are being requested for 2 locations within the township.

Correspondence and Permits were read and reviewed.

Michael Whitman motioned to sign Bills & Payroll for February 27, 2020, James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Whitman moved, seconded by James Glover to adjourn the regular meeting at 7:37 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
