

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – April 8, 2020

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held April 8, 2020. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Porter, Drew Francisco, and Catherine Wise. Due to Corvid-19 the public was asked not to attend in person, but were asked to submit questions to the Supervisors and staff via phone calls.

James Glover motioned to approve the minutes from the March 25, 2020 Regular Meeting, Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for April 9, 2020 - General Fund \$69,757.12 and State Fund - \$141,540.46, Michael Porter seconded. Motion carried.

James Glover motioned to purchase a paver to be used to spread millings on roads, at a cost of \$8,900.00. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter motioned to sign the County Aid form to receive a refund for a bridge inspection on Moore Road. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter motioned to sign The Brine Agreement with Pennfield Energy. James Glover seconded. All voted yes. Two tanks will be purchased to be used by the township to store brine for use. This will reduce the amount of hours needed to brine roads.

The ECGRA loan for \$125,000.00 at 2.5 percent interest was reviewed. A resolution and the legal papers will need to be signed after a few revisions are made to the pages. Tabled until next meeting.

Resident Doug Sipple called at 8:27 a.m. to speak with the Supervisors about the road in front of his house on Old Frisbeetown Road. Supervisors stated that they would take a look at it and that they are planning on graveling that road this summer.

Road Foreman Report: Trees have been cut on Old Frisbeetown Road. Grading and the changing of pipes has been done on various roads.

Discussion was held on Holmes Road: A resident ditched the east side of the road without approval from the township. This is causing a problem with water flow. The ditch is in the township right of way. Supervisors are debating what action to take in this matter. Tabled.

In regards to the bidding out tar & chip. LeBoeuf Township and Mill Village Borough are working on a joint bid. Tabled. Municipal Services Rep - Josh Montgomery will be asked to help with the bid.

The following will be posted on the Website and Facebook: Supervisors are requesting residents to report people who are seen destroying and damaging roads and signs within the township. If anyone is caught they will be punished to the full extent of the law. If video or pictures are possible, anyone who can be identified will be held responsible for damages.

Correspondence was read and reviewed.

James Glover motioned to sign Bills & Payroll for April 9 2020, Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter moved, seconded by James Glove rto adjourn the regular meeting at 9:09 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.
