

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – March 11, 2020

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held March 11, 2020. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Whitman, Michael Porter, Drew Francisco, Edward & Linda Falconer, Shawn McLaughlin and Catherine Wise.

Michael Whitman motioned to approve the minutes from the February 26, 2020 Regular Meeting, James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for March 12, 2020 - General Fund \$83,839.16 and State Fund - \$165,500.89, Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

Linda Falconer – President of Mill Village Borough Council and Council members Edward Falconer and Shawn McLaughlin attended the meeting to discuss road improvements to Dutchtown Road. The road is shared by both municipalities from Route 6 South to Woods Road. The Mill Village Borough Council is in agreement to pay for half the cost of materials and application of millings to the road, with the stipulation that a tar & chip seal be applied.

Edward & Linda Falconer and Shawn McLaughlin left the meeting at 8:30 a.m.

The EMS meeting was held at the American Legion in Union City on March 5, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. Michael Whitman and Catherine Wise attended. Information was acquired and another meeting will be held in the future to include members of fire departments.

Road Foreman Report: More millings have been hauled in. Cold Patch was applied to Old Route 19. Tires were installed on the John Deere Grader. Prices are being acquired for cost of renting equipment such as a Dozer, and Excavator for use of applying millings on Township Roads. Discussion was held on different applications for the placement of the millings, crushing & screening of the millings and whether to borrow money for a tar & chip application after placing the millings. Supervisors discussed which roads (Stone Quarry, Old Meadville, Dutchtown South) should be improved and/or tarred & chipped. Supervisors Michael Whitman and Michael Porter agreed to bid out 2 miles of tar & chip for 2020 to be placed on Stone Quarry and Dutchtown roads to seal applied millings. Loan interest rates will be presented at the next meeting.

Correspondence and Permits were read and reviewed.

James Glover motioned to sign Bills & Payroll for March 12, 2020, Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved, seconded by Michael Porter to adjourn the regular meeting at 9:37 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.
