

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – March 25, 2020

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held March 25, 2020. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Whitman, Michael Porter, Drew Francisco, and Catherine Wise. Due to Corvid-19 the public was asked not to attend in person, but were asked to submit questions to the Supervisors and staff via phone calls. No calls were received.

Michael Whitman motioned to approve the minutes from the March 11, 2020 Regular Meeting, Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for March 26, 2020 - General Fund \$72,163.24 and State Fund - \$149,855.58, Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

The Spring Newsletter was reviewed.

Supervisors received the Mill Village Volunteer Fire Company's Ambulance Financial Report.

Discussion was held on the Paid Staffing Fund.

The Lindy Paving credit application was signed.

Covid -19 : Supervisors discussed protocols in place inside the building for the Pandemic. At present time all foot traffic has been suspended. The employees will continue to work. No part-time employees will be called in for road work at this time. The Supervisors will continue to meet regularly, with everyone keeping 6 feet apart and the public asked to call in all questions and concerns before or during the meeting to any staff or Supervisors.

Loan interest rates to be used for the Tar & Chip project were presented. The ECGRA loan is 2.5 percent and Northwest Bank is 4.5 percent.

Road Foreman Report: Drew presented costs for Road Improvements to Stone Quarry, Dutchtown and Old Meadville Roads.

Discussion was held on purchasing a paver to be used to spread millings on roads. Drew will travel to New York State to look at it within the week. Cost is \$8,900.00.

Supervisors also discussed costs for screening and crushing of Millings (\$2.75 - \$5.00 per yard) and Loader rental costs.

Drew is working on bidding out tar & chip. Discussion was held on piggybacking with Washington Township or using Mark Corey's multi-municipal bid, or bidding it out with the inclusion of Mill Village Borough amounts. Approximately 3 miles of tar & chip will be bid out. Tabled.

Russell Standard will be reviewing Union LeBoeuf Road within the next few weeks.

Correspondence was read and reviewed.

Michael Whitman motioned to sign Bills & Payroll for March 26, 2020, James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Whitman moved, seconded by Michael Porter to adjourn the regular meeting at 7:26p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
