

## LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – June 10, 2020

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held June 10, 2020. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Porter, Michael Whitman, Bill Cornwell, Greg Flak, , Pam Lindberg, Edward Falconer, Drew Francisco, and Catherine Wise.

Michael Whitman motioned to approve the minutes from the May 27, 2020 Regular Meeting, Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for June 4, 2020 - General Fund \$123,252.33 and State Fund - \$100,903.04, Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

### Public Comment:

Resident Greg Flack spoke with the Supervisors about Dump Trucks on Mystic road and stated that the roads are getting better, but Mystic Road may need some additional maintenance, due to the Township owned Gravel Pit. He was encouraged by the fact that LeBoeuf Township is beginning to tar & chip roads with millings as a base and would like Mystic to be placed on the list for future tar and chip projects.

Resident Pam Lindberg attended to ask when Old Meadville Road will be brined and to inform the Supervisors that her ditch needs cleaned out again. Supervisors stated that the Road Crew will grade and brine when brine is available and the weather is in agreement with working hours. She also would like her road tar & chipped.

Edward Falconer was present to discuss the current tar & chip project. The township can add up to 10% of costs to the original bid. Discussion was held on the road choices for an extension to the project. Michael Porter motioned to add the 10% to the original bid package, Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes. Michael Whitman motioned to spend the additional monies for tar & chip on Dutchtown North – to be shared with Mill Village Borough. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Mr. Falconer also stated that the driveway and pipe at the Cemetery needs fixed/replaced.

Road Foreman Report: The gravel crushing has been completed. All the millings have been picked up from PennDOT. The Screening of millings is scheduled for the first week in July. Grading and Brining has begun. The Cemetery Project is almost completed.

Supervisors changed "2 Paid Holidays" to "2 Floating Holidays" in 2020.

James Glover motioned to close Moore Road until September 2020. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes. Solicitor Chris Sennett will be asked to draft a resolution.

Discussion was held on a section of Old Route 19 South. The residents would like to know who owns the section of road and who is responsible to maintain it. Josh Montgomery will be called to check on Liquid Fuels payments.

PennDOT is finishing work on the Stone Quarry Road bridge; that was begun last year. The bridge will be closed from June 29<sup>th</sup> to July 3<sup>rd</sup> for resurfacing.

Discussion was held on performing a study to place Speed limit signs on Old Meadville and Stone Quarry Roads after the Tar & Chip projects are completed.

One permit was received. Correspondence, Resolutions and Special Exemptions were reviewed. Zoning officer Bill Cornwell discussed the property on French Creek Road owned by Mr. McWilliams.

A letter will be sent to the resident on Old Route 19 to inform them of the Maintenance Ordinance and to ask them not to park on the road.

Correspondence & permits were read and reviewed.

Michael Whitman motioned to ratify Bills & Payroll for June 4, 2020, James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Whitman moved, seconded by James Glover, to adjourn the regular meeting at 9:23 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.
