

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – May 27, 2020

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held May 27, 2020. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Porter, Michael Whitman, Drew Francisco, and Catherine Wise. Edward Falconer arrived at 6:15.

Michael Whitman motioned to approve the minutes from the May 13, 2020 Regular Meeting, Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Whitman motioned to approve the minutes from the May 20, 2020 Special Meeting, James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for May 21, 2020 - General Fund \$122,871.91 and State Fund - \$114,462.13, Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

Edward Falconer was present to discuss the MVVFC Paid Staffing contract. The Mill Village Borough Council members are working on a separate tax to fund the fire department and ambulance. The Supervisors would like to invite the Fire Department to attend a meeting to discuss the current plans of the Fire Department to purchase an Ambulance and the funding of the Paid Staffing Fund.

Michael Porter motioned to sign the Memorandum of Understanding – Extending the Paid Staffing Fund Contract until December 31, 2020, Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes. . A meeting will be set up in August to start discussing the contract renewal and funds to be paid.

Residents on Flatts Road would like to purchase No Parking Signs and Posts for in front of their house. Supervisors agreed if the residents purchase the signs, the township will erect them.

Discussion was held on repairing or replacing the furnace units in the garage. Quotes will be acquired.

Michael Whitman motioned to sign Resolution #3 of 2020 – Tax Sale. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Road Foreman Report: Brine will begin next week. North & South Dutchtown and Moore road residents have called about dust.

Russell Standard completed the warranty work on Union LeBoeuf and Old Meadville Roads. Mr. Etheridge on Union LeBoeuf still wants more "chip" placed in front of his property.

The Hydraulics on Paver are being repaired. Crushing of Gravel is almost complete. Dwyer Plumbing will begin screening of millings within the next week.

Supervisors discussed whether Old Meadville Road is a designated Snowmobile/ATV Road. The Supervisors decided that it is not a designated road and that all state laws pertaining to the driving of Snowmobiles, ATV's and other such vehicles can be enforced by the State Police.

Michael Whitman motioned to give Chris Gundlach a raise of \$1.00 to \$17.00 per hour and to pay Laborer Charlie Cornwell \$10.00 per hour. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Correspondence & permits were read and reviewed.

Michael Whitman motioned to ratify Bills & Payroll for May 21, 2020, James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Whitman moved, seconded by Michael Porter, to adjourn the regular meeting at 7:16 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
