

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – July 8, 2020

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held July 8, 2020. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Porter, Michael Whitman, Ron Lewis, Linda Fitzgibbon, Mary Cummings, Richard & Marjorie Wilkins, William Manno, Kelly & Jerry Port, Ed Falconer, Joe Cunningham, Bill Cornwell, Drew Francisco, and Catherine Wise.

Michael Whitman motioned to approve the minutes from the June 24, 2020 Regular Meeting, Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for July 2, 2020 - General Fund \$107,474.35 and State Fund - \$84,189.66, Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

Mr. Manno and Mr. & Mrs. Wilkins were present to sign the Agreement for the Vacation of Dewey Road from the Bridge over French Creek to Stone Quarry Road. The Road will be vacated by the township and Mr. Manno will own half of the road and Mr. & Mrs. Wilkins will take ownership of the other half. The Road will be considered a Private Drive and be blocked to traffic at the Stone Quarry Road entrance, along with the Bridge being barricaded off to any traffic. An Ordinance to officially vacate the road will be advertised for a public hearing at the next meeting.

Discussion was held on the temporary closing of Moore Road, due to the bridge on Route 19 reconstruction. Joe Cunningham requested that the road stay open; to ensure that Emergency Vehicles from Waterford have access to respond to emergency calls at the ball fields on Route 19, at his establishment, as well as other times of increased business, such as Thursday Night Bike Night. Mr. Lewis and his daughters Linda Fitzgibbon and Mary Cummings were present to ask the township to close the road to through traffic due to the dust from the road and the damage that increased vehicles are causing on the gravel road. Supervisors will attempt to place blocks on the road to limit truck traffic and the State Police will be advised to monitor the road for violators.

Edward Falconer left at 8:30. He was present to ask about the tar & chip project dates for Dutchtown Road.

Kelly Port read a statement, with her concerns regarding Zoning Officer William Cornwell making a personal phone call, to one of her customers regarding her business dealings with that customer. (Letter on file) Zoning Officer William Cornwell apologized for his actions and stated that he will resign from his position.

There will be an Assessment Hearing for the Mystic Road Gravel Pit on August 3, 2020.

Road Foreman Report: (Drew Francisco on vacation) Supervisor Michael Whitman gave the report: Grading and Brining was performed on Vincent, Flaugh, Dutchtown and Waite Roads. Crushing of Millings will begin on July 13th and will be placed on Dutchtown Road from July 15th – 16th. He also explained, to the Residents in attendance, which roads will be tarred & chipped this year and why. PennDOT has informed LeBoeuf Township that the bridge on Stone Quarry Road is slated to be re-opened July 9, 2020.

Mr. & Mrs. Wilkins and Mr. Manno left the meeting at 8:37 a.m.

Kelly & Jerry Port and Mr. Lewis & Family left at 8:50 a.m. Joe Cunningham left at 8:58 a.m.

Zoning Officer Bill Cornwell presented 2 permits. Bill Cornwell gave the Supervisors his side of the story concerning Port Farms. After much consideration, Supervisor Michael Porter accepted the resignation with regrets, Supervisor Michael Whitman seconded. Michael Porter and Michael Whitman voted yes. Supervisor James Glover voted no. Motion carried.

Correspondence & permits were read and reviewed.

Michael Whitman motioned to ratify Bills & Payroll for July 2, 2020, James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter moved, seconded by James Glover, to adjourn the regular meeting at 9:20 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.
