

## **LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – August 26, 2020**

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held August 26, 2020. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Whitman, Michael Porter, Ron Ethridge, Bill Cornwell, Shelly Dzeskewicz, Ed Falconer, Drew Francisco, and Catherine Wise. Zoning Officer Tim Pie arrived at 6:30 p.m.

Michael Porter motioned to approve the minutes from the August 12, 2020 Regular Meeting, Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Reports for August 27, 2020 - General Fund \$76,460.15 and State Fund - \$50,441.79 Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

Resident Ron Ethridge stated that "chip" was placed on Union LeBoeuf Road as requested, but it wasn't rolled in properly. He was informed that the road will not be paved anytime in the future.

Bill Cornwell asked the Supervisors what he would need to do to have the front half of his property rezoned from Residential to Agriculture. Information will be acquired in regards to this. He also asked if the sale of Christmas trees require a Logging Permit. Supervisors will review the Logging ordinance. Bill Cornwell would like his permit revised for his new pole barn.

Ed Falconer stated that Mill Village Borough will be passing a Fire Tax at their next meeting, then he feels that a letter will need to be sent to the Mill Village Volunteer Fire Company and EMT Program, that the current contract will not be renewed. The next meeting with the Fire Company and EMT personnel in regards to the paid Staffing Program is September 16, 2020 at 6:30 p.m. at the Fire Hall. Ed Falconer left at 7:10 p.m.

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors discussed enacting a Temporary Road Improvement Tax. They considered placing a question of the ballot asking if residents would be willing to pay an extra tax for approximately 5 years to improve the graveled roads and convert them to millings with tar & chip. The Supervisors would like to hold a Public Meeting to discuss this option. The Supervisors will also consider applying for Grants and Loans to complete the roads.

Supervisors would also like to see more Businesses being located within the township to bring in additional revenue.

Shelly Dzeskewicz was present to discuss the future of the roads.

Road Foreman Report: Drew Francisco reported that the Tar & Chip Project has been completed. Graveling will commence on Old Frisbeetown Road. A loader was rented for the graveling project – which allowed the trucks to be loaded out of the gravel pit at a faster rate. Drew is looking into the purchase of more millings for next year's projects. Supervisors stated that they would like to Thank the Glovers for the use of their gravel pit to store the millings used for this year's project.

Correspondence & permits were read and reviewed.

James Glover motioned to sign Bills & Payroll for August 27, 2020, Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved, seconded by Michael Whitman, to adjourn the regular meeting at 7:49 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
