

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – September 9, 2020

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held September 9, 2020. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Whitman, Michael Porter, Tim Pie, Drew Francisco, and Catherine Wise.

Michael Whitman motioned to approve the minutes from the August 26, 2020 Regular Meeting, Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Reports for September 10, 2020 - General Fund \$66,456.27 and State Fund - \$44,355.31 Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

The Western New York and Pennsylvania Railroad has removed the crossing on Dewey Road. Blocks placed at the location, to prohibit vehicles from crossing tracks, were moved. A representative from the railroad has requested the placement of metal barriers across the bridge to prevent access. The railroad employee offered to construct the barriers. LeBoeuf Township Supervisors will work with the Railroad to barricade both sides of the bridge and prevent access.

Michael Whitman motioned to sign Resolution #3 of 2020 – The EACOG Audit approval, James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter motioned to accept the Resignation of Zoning Hearing Board member Larry Hanas, with regrets. Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes. A new Hearing Board member will be appointed at a later date.

Supervisors discussed the Cares Act Grants. Michael Whitman motioned to sign the Cares Act Grant Resolution, Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes. If the township is eligible, funds will be requested.

Michael Porter motioned to add the following to the LeBoeuf Township Fee Schedule: Amendments to the Zoning Ordinance – Requested by land owner - \$500.00 fee. Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes. Discussion was held on Armstrong Internet. A request will be made for a report on the progress of expansion within LeBoeuf Township..

Road Foreman Report: Drew Francisco discussed the cost for Road Improvement Projects – Current and Future. The township is scouting for the purchase of additional millings to use for next year's projects. The Low Volume Road Grant Application has been submitted to the Erie County Conservation District for a replacement of the bridge on McGahen Hill Road.

Tim Pie reported that the Variance was granted to Nate Otis and Lisbeth Burnett on Route 19. Discussion was held on the property at 14422 Dutchtown Road. Zoning Officer Tim Pie stated that after further investigation, the property should be condemned and people should not be living in the residence. A registered letter will be sent to the land owner, requesting compliance with Ordinance #2 -2019 – The Property Maintenance Ordinance. Also, going forward, a list will be constructed of all residences which are blatantly in violation of the Property Maintenance Ordinance and letters will be mailed.

Correspondence & permits were read and reviewed.

Michael Whitman motioned to sign Bills & Payroll for September 10, 2020, James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved, seconded by Michael Whitman, to adjourn the regular meeting at 9:28 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.
