

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – October 14, 2020

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held October 14, 2020. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Whitman, Michael Porter, Tim Pie, Bill Cornwell, Kevin Henry, Jason Walker, Rich Gillespie, Drew Francisco and Catherine Wise.

Michael Porter motioned to approve the minutes from the September 23, 2020 Regular Meeting, Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Reports for October 8, 2020 - General Fund \$36,285.80 and State Fund - \$35,565.42. Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

Michael Whitman motioned to sign the Tomoschenko Subdivision. James Glover seconded. All voted yes. The Subdivision was signed, and Jason Walker left at 8:16 a.m.

Kevin Henry, representative from 5-Star Equipment and Rich Gillespie, representative from Cleveland Bros. Equipment both presented quotes for a new Road Grader. Each presented various graders to be purchased at State Contract prices. Many different options were explained. The Supervisors and Road Foreman will review the proposals. Mr. Henry and Mr. Gillespie left at 8:40 a.m.

Michael Porter motioned to sign the Edwards Subdivision; Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter motioned to adopt Ordinance #3 of 2020 and appoint Chairman James Glover to sign the proposed Ordinance. Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes. Motion Carried.

Three Candidates submitted their names for the vacant Zoning Hearing Board position. William Cornwell, Frank Concoby and Richard Gilmore. After discussion, Michael Porter motioned to appoint Richard Gilmore to the position of Zoning Hearing Board member – replacing Larry Hanas. James Glover seconded. All voted yes. Motion Carried.

The 2020/2021 Fall/Winter newsletter was reviewed. It will be posted on the Website. A Road Improvement Questionnaire was developed and will be posted on the website and available at the Township Building.

Road Foreman Report: Drew Francisco spoke with Engineer Mark Corey. They reviewed Act 13 Bridge Funds for various bridges. An electrical surge damaged the Traffic Light panel box, it has been temporarily repaired. The damage will be turned into the Insurance Company along with everything that will need replaced. The Garage Furnace needs replaced: Two quotes have been acquired one from LeBoeuf Industries and one from Spaeder Electric. Supervisors requested one more quote from either Tim Yapple Electric or Scobel Electric before deciding on a plan.

The berms are being backfilled on the 2020 Tar & Chip projects. Mowing is being done. Discussion was held on selling the Dresser Grader-As Is. Supervisors also discussed whether to trade in or keep the John Deere Grader. Comparable prices will be acquired for review. No decisions were made.

Discussion was held on Indian Head Drive, Oneida Drive & Mohawk Drive concerning access to a property. Supervisors stated that these are Private Drives – Public Right of Ways. Any concerns regarding these drives are a civil matter.

Correspondence & permits were read and reviewed.

Bill Cornwell needs the ditch in front of his pond cleaned out.

Michael Whitman motioned to ratify Bills & Payroll for October 8, 2020. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Whitman moved, seconded by Michael Porter, to adjourn the regular meeting at 9:45 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.
