

## **LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – October 28, 2020**

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held October 28, 2020. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Porter, Bill Cornwell, Kevin Henry, Edward Falconer and Catherine Wise.

Michael Porter motioned to approve the minutes from the October 14, 2020 Regular Meeting, James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Reports for October 22, 2020 - General Fund \$45,091.64, State Fund - \$30,811.51. Michael Porter seconded. Motion carried.

Kevin Henry, representative from 5-Star Equipment presented trade in values for the John Deere Grader - \$10,000.00 and the Dresser Grader -\$6,500.00. The Quoted amounts are good for 2 months. Discussion was held on Interest rates and payments for various new graders.

James Glover motioned to Repeal Resolution #1 of 2020 – Approving the issuance of a loan for \$125,000.00, Mike Porter seconded. All voted yes. Motion carried. The loan for \$45,000.00 was tabled.

The Insurance Company will send a check for all the repairs needed on the Traffic Light.

The Furnace for the garage was tabled until another quote can be obtained.

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors will hold a Budget Workshop, Wednesday November 11, 2020 following the regular meeting – Approximately 9:00 a.m.

Discussion was held on purchasing Millings from the City of Erie. – Tabled.

Edward Falconer stated that the Mill Village Borough Council would be willing to piggy-back on the purchase of Tar & Chip projects in 2021.

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors are waiting to hear from agencies on a grant for the McGahen Hill Road Bridge project.

The Questionnaires, in regard to an Increase of Taxes for Road Improvements, have been posted on the LeBoeuf Township Website and will be available for residents, to fill out and submit, at the municipal building, during the general election on November 3, 2020.

Michael Porter motioned to change the time for the Supervisors Meeting on November 25, 2020 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Road Foreman Report: Started Fall Grading. The Snowplows and trucks are almost ready for the Winter season. Ditches were cleaned out on Old Meadville Road.

Correspondence was read and reviewed.

James Glover motioned to ratify Bills & Payroll for October 22, 2020. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter moved, seconded by James Glover, to adjourn the regular meeting at 6:59 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
