

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – December 23, 2020

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held December 23, 2020. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Whitman, Tim Pie, Drew Francisco and Catherine Wise. Michael Porter arrived at 9:35 a.m.

James Glover motioned to approve the minutes from the December 9, 2020 Regular Meeting, Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Reports for December 3, 2020- Revised General Fund \$47,034.43 and State Fund - \$9,720.14. and December 17, 2020 - General Fund \$76,931.34 and State Fund - \$4,381.11. Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

Michael Whitman motioned to sign the Understanding of Services from Buseck, Barger, Bleil & Co. for the 2020 Audit. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Supervisors were not interested in signing up for any ECATO Committees.

Due to a schedule conflict, The Supervisors Re-Org Meeting will be held on Monday, January 4, 2021 at 3:00 p.m. It will be advertised.

Employee Health Insurance for 2021: Michael Whitman discussed setting up a Health Savings Reimbursement Account in Lieu of paying Health Insurance Premiums for both full time employees. Both employees have coverage under another policy. Each Employee would receive \$3,500.00 to be used towards health care costs in 2021 with an annual taxable buyout at the end of the year. This would give LeBoeuf Township a reduction of over \$5,000.00 in health care costs for the year. Tabled.

2021 Supervisors Enactments – Michael Whitman motioned to set the LeBoeuf Township millage at 1.5% (Raised .5%) Michael Porter seconded. Michael Porter and Michael Whitman voted yes. James Glover voted no. Motion carried.

Michael Whitman motioned to set Income Tax at 1%, receiving 0.5%, Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes. Motion Carried.

Michael Whitman motioned to set Realty Transfer tax at 1%, receiving 0.5% Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes. Motion Carried.

Michael Whitman motioned to set LST at \$52.00 per year, receiving \$47.00, FLB School District Receiving \$5.00. Michael Porter seconded All voted yes. Motion Carried. The LST revenue will be paid to the Mill Village Volunteer Fire Company – Paid Staffing Fund.

Michael Porter motioned to approve the 2021 Budget with corrections, Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes. Motion Carried.

Michael Whitman motioned to pay Russell Standard with a check from the Line of Credit at Northwest Bank. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Due to cost & complications the Loan Application for \$46,000.00 will be nullified.

Road Foreman Report: Drew Francisco reported that the road crew is Plowing when needed and hauling millings. They placed limestone on Mystic Road. The New Cabinet for the Traffic Light will be installed in January 2021. Discussion was held on purchasing 1 mile of Seal Coat (Tar & Chip) on County Contract. – Tabled.

Zoning officer Tim Pie reported that permits were issued for Recreational Vehicles. He issued a permit for Debrakeleers at Mill Run Collision and suggested having inspections for their addition. Solicitor Chris Sennet will be contacted, in regards to the property on Dutchtown Road that has not made any attempt at cleaning up the property according to the ordinance.

Correspondence and Permits were read and reviewed.

James Glover motioned to ratify Bills & Payroll for December 17, 2020. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter moved, seconded by Michael Whitman, to adjourn the regular meeting at 9:45 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.
