

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – February 10, 2021

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held February 10, 2021. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Whitman, Michael Porter, Tim Pie, Drew Francisco and Catherine Wise.

James Glover motioned to approve the minutes from the January 27, 2021 Regular Meeting as corrected. Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Reports for February 11, 2021– General Fund: \$28,353.31 and State Fund: \$2,599.24. Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

Michael Porter motioned to sign the Hepler Subdivision; James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter motioned to use County Aid monies for Seal Coat Costs in 2021. Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Whitman motioned to appoint Chairman James Glover to sign the E.L. Heard Fuel Tax pages. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Supervisors discussed the lack of Erie County Tax funds that the Township receives. They would like to take the matter of funding to Erie County Council members and State Senator Michelle Brooks.

Road Foreman Report: Drew Francisco reported that we will be bidding 2 miles of Seal Coat with the Erie County COG in 2021. The Road Crew has been Plowing and Cindering. Discussion was held on trading gravel for either millings or screening & crushing services. Solicitor Chris Sennett will be consulted on this. Empire Trucking has 5 trucks ready to haul aggregates for the township.

Zoning officer Tim Pie discussed the upcoming hearing scheduled for February 26, 2021 with the Supervisors. The Supervisors addressed a complaint form and decided that it is a civil matter, and they are not going to pursue the complaint at this time.

Correspondence was read and reviewed.

Michael Whitman motioned to sign Bills & Payroll for February 11, 2021. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Whitman moved, seconded by Michael Porter, to adjourn the regular meeting at 9:47 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.
