

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – January 27, 2021

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held January 27, 2021. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Whitman, Michael Porter, Tim Pie, Drew Francisco and Catherine Wise.

Michael Whitman motioned to approve the minutes from the January 4, 2021 Reorg Meeting and the January 4, 2021 Regular Meeting as written and as submitted, Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes. James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Reports for December 31, 2020-Revised General Fund: \$62,547.96 and State Fund - \$3,615.98. January 14, 2021 - General Fund: \$56,277.39 and State Fund: \$2,653.15 and January 28, 2021 – General Fund: \$43,639.22 and State Fund: \$2,599.21. Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

Two bids were received for trucking. Cindy Glover trucking bid \$75.00 per hour. Empire Trucking \$64.50 per hour. Michael Porter motioned to award bid to Empire Trucking. Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter motioned to sign Resolution #1 of 2021 – Waive Fees for Property Taxes for 2021, Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes.

Septic/Sewage Forms were reviewed and signed. County Aid was discussed. Josh Montgomery will be contacted about allowable expenditures. Buseck, Barger Bleil & Col are almost done with the Tax Collector Audits they stated that LeBoeuf Township is not owed outstanding funds. Supervisors decided that Zoning Officer payments and Zoning Fees will remain the same at this time.

Road Foreman Report: Drew Francisco reported that the Dresser Grader has been sold for \$8,500.00. The Mystic Road Bridge and McGahen Hill Bridge Replacements have been approved. Discussion was held on purchasing Seal Coat with the County Bid. Gravel Screening and Crushing was discussed. Supervisors are considering the cost of rental versus purchase of a used screener. The township purchased a used loader. Drew presented approximate figures for the improvement of all township roads.

Zoning officer Tim Pie reported that more pictures have been taken of the Laffan Property for the Hearing. Discussion was held on the Lesik Property. Items have been removed from the property line.

Correspondence and Permits were read and reviewed.

Michael Whitman motioned to ratify Bills & Payroll for December 14, 2021. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Whitman motioned to sign Bills & Payroll for December 28, 2021. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Whitman moved, seconded by Michael Porter, to adjourn the regular meeting at 7:40 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
