

## **LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – February 24, 2021**

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held February 24, 2021. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Porter, Tim Pietrasewicz, Drew Francisco and Catherine Wise. Also in attendance: Resident Mike Porsch and County Councilman Scott Rastetter.

James Glover motioned to approve the minutes from the February 10, 2021 Regular Meeting. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Reports for February 25, 2021– General Fund: \$22,064.28 and State Fund: \$2,599.24. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$7,500.04. Line of Credit: Spent: \$70,423.34, Remaining: \$29,576.66. Michael Porter seconded. Motion carried.

Resident Mike Porsche had questions about installing a driveway on Indian Head Drive. He left at 6:15 p.m. after receiving instruction.

County Councilman Scott Rastetter presence was requested in regard to a lack of funding for municipalities from the County of Erie. LeBoeuf Township Supervisors would like additional funds to help with Roads and Bridges. Councilman Rastetter spoke about the services that the County of Erie does provide such as Health Services and Payrolls for various County Services such as Judges, Sherriff's Department, etc. Councilman Rastetter left the meeting at 6:39 p.m.

Michael Porter motioned to pass Resolution #2 of 2021 – The Joseph Cunningham Small Flow System. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

The Supervisors reviewed the Shearer Foods Wastewater application. It will be signed and sent back.

Road Foreman Report: Drew Francisco reported that plowing and cindering has been continuing. The Road crew has been clearing tree branches from roadways. The new loader will be picked up within the next 2 weeks. The Dresser Grader is ready to go as soon as payment is received.

Zoning officer Tim Pietrasewicz discussed the impending hearing. Due to the fact that the Residents cleaned up the property within the past week, Solicitor Chris Sennet has advised to cancel the hearing. The Supervisors agreed to drop the court case, after adjourning to an executive meeting from 7:09 to 7:15 to discuss the matter.

Correspondence was read and reviewed.

Michael Porter motioned to sign Bills & Payroll for February 25, 2021. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter moved, seconded by James Glover, to adjourn the regular meeting at 7:21 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
