

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – March 10, 2021

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held March 10, 2021. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Porter, Tim Pietrasewicz, Tom McClure, Drew Francisco and Catherine Wise.

James Glover motioned to approve the minutes from the February 24, 2021 Regular Meeting. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Reports for March 11, 2021– General Fund: \$44,340.39 and State Fund: \$149,583.55. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$7,500.33. Line of Credit: Spent: \$40,000.00, Remaining: \$60,000.00. Michael Porter seconded. Motion carried.

Tom McClure from the Erie County Conservation District presented options for the McGahen Hill Bridge Replacement Project. The Permits have been obtained and the original design may be adjusted. Michael Porter motioned to approve Option #2 –9' 8" x 70' Bridge Deck/Total Cost: \$183,890.87.: The Bridge Grant awarded is approximately \$148,324.00. James Glover seconded. All voted yes. Tom McClure left at 8:32 a.m.

Michael Porter motioned to sign and set the Letter to Erie County Representatives concerning State Police Coverage and unfunded mandates. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Supervisors received a letter from the LeBoeuf Township Planning Commission with suggestions for amendments to the LeBoeuf Township Zoning Ordinance. The suggestions will be forwarded to Solicitor Chris Sennett to be drawn up and passed in 2021.

Road Master Michel Porter stated that Logging Permits should not be issued at this time, due to frost in the roadways.

Road Foreman Report: Drew Francisco reported that they will be starting grading roads. They have been servicing equipment. Trees were cut on Mystic Road, McGahen Hill Road and Smith Road.

Zoning officer Tim Pietrasewicz reported that the DEP is looking into the house built on French Creek Road. It may be in violation of the Flood Plain.

The Spring Newsletter was reviewed.

Correspondence was read and reviewed.

James Glover motioned to sign Bills & Payroll for March 11, 2021. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter moved, seconded by James Glover, to adjourn the regular meeting at 9:26 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.
