

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – March 24, 2021

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held March 24, 2021. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Porter, Tim Pietrasewicz, Bob & Jayne Rindfuss, Drew Francisco and Catherine Wise.

Michael Porter motioned to approve the minutes from the March 10, 2021 Regular Meeting. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Reports for March 25, 2021– General Fund: \$16,929.02 and State Fund: \$143,703.71. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$6,703.82. Line of Credit: Spent: \$40,000.00, Remaining: \$60,000.00. Michael Porter seconded. Motion carried.

The Township will be receiving funds from the American Rescue Plan – A 1-Trillion Covid Relief Bill. The allotted amount for LeBoeuf Township is \$162,045.00 paid over a 2-year period, to be used by the year 2024. Supervisors will check into allowable uses for the funds.

Bob & Jayne Rindfuss discussed Indian Head Drive – it was stated that this is a Private Drive – Public Right of Way. Residents cannot block this Right of Way, but it is not maintained by LeBoeuf Township and any matters concerning landowners is a Civil matter.

The DEP has sent a letter concerning floodway obstruction at the McWilliams building on French Creek Road.

Road Foreman Report: Drew Francisco reported that LeBoeuf Township received an Emergency Permit to replace the failed pipe on Old Route 19. Discussion was held on Brine for the 2021 season. Quotes will be received for other outlets. The Traffic Light electric box has been completed. Grading is being done on various roads. A ditch may need to be dug on Dutchtown Road to alleviate water under the road.

Zoning officer Tim Pietrasewicz reported that he is working on Clean-up Day. Residents will be able to bring up to 1 pick-up truck load of junk and up to 3 electronics for disposal. Discussion was held on the Junk yard on Mystic Road and the Fence surrounding, it will need to be removed, for this summer's pipe replacement project. A letter will be sent. Tim suggested having Port Farms apply for a Special Events permit for a concert they are holding in May 2021.

The Spring Newsletter and Clean-up letter were reviewed. Revisions will be made.

Correspondence was read and reviewed.

Michael Whitman motioned to sign Bills & Payroll for March 25, 2021. Michael James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Whitman moved, seconded by Michael Porter, to adjourn the regular meeting at 7:30 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
