

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – April 28, 2021

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held April 28, 2021. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Porter, Michael Whitman, Mark Corey, Bill Manno, Ed Falconer, Tim Pietrasewicz, Drew Francisco and Catherine Wise.

Michael Whitman motioned to approve the minutes from the April 14, 2021 Regular Meeting. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Reports for April 22, 2021– General Fund: \$15,384.00 and State Fund: \$122,923.57. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$6,704.13. Line of Credit: Spent: \$20,000.00, Remaining: \$80,000.00. Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

Engineer Mark Corey attended the meeting to inform the Supervisors that the McGahen Hill Road Bridge is eligible for Act 13 grant monies. This will pay for the LeBoeuf Township share of the Project. He also spoke with the Supervisors concerning the bidding of both bridge projects in 2021 – Mystic Road and McGahen Hill Road. Both projects bid advertisements will be in the newspaper next week.

Mr. Bill Manno asked the LeBoeuf Township Supervisors about the barricading of Dewey Road at the Stone Quarry Intersection. He feels that Penelec may need access to Electric Lines, but he does not want cars to have access to the road. Supervisors are considering enclosing the road and installing a gate with a Private Property/Road Closed sign.

Ed Falconer spoke with the Supervisors about placing 3 loads of limestone on Woods Road from the edge of the Blacktop west past the Malinowski's driveway. Mill Village Borough Council is willing to split the cost. Additionally, a pipe in that section of road will need replaced.

Road Foreman Report: Drew Francisco reported that spring grading is complete. Tiling was done on Old Meadville Road – a sink hole was fixed with this project. Discussion was held on the cost of tiling various township roads, which needs completed before additional tar & chip is placed. Quotes for tiling have been obtained from Ed Musgrave – 75 cents per foot, Showmans – 85 cents per foot and Empire Trenching – 75 cent per foot. Tabled. Supervisors are looking into Stormwater Management efforts being paid for by the American Rescue Plan monies. The Cussewago Grader is ready to be picked up. The Pennfield Brine agreement was signed.

The ECATO Yearbook Dinner was discussed. The 2020 Township Audit has been completed. The 2017/2018 Tax Collector Audit has been completed.

Zoning Officer Tim Pietrasewicz reported that the dumpsters for Clean-up Day have been ordered. Tim asked that the Supervisors and Staff help on Clean-up Day.

Correspondence and Permits were read and reviewed.

Michael Whitman motioned to ratify Bills & Payroll for April 22, 2021. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter moved, seconded by Michael Whitman, to adjourn the regular meeting at 7:35 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
