

## LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – June 9, 2021

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held June 9, 2021. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Porter, Michael Whitman, Corporal Williams, Tim Pietrasewicz, Drew Francisco and Catherine Wise.

Michael Whitman motioned to approve the minutes from the May 26, 2021, Regular Meeting. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Reports for June 3, 2021– General Fund: \$50,006.76 and State Fund: \$96,581.05. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$6,704.13. Line of Credit: Spent: \$19,000.00, Remaining: \$81,000.00. Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

Corporal Williams from the Pennsylvania State Police was present to discuss issues within the township. Supervisors asked him about littering and tannerite, which are problems within the township at this time.

The amendments to the Zoning Ordinance were presented. Erie County Planning is performing a 30-day review, along with the LeBoeuf Township Planning Commission.

Michael Whitman motioned to approve the signing of the Mystic Road Project forms, by Chairman James Glover, Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Discussion was held on the ARPA Federal Funds. A SAMS# must be obtained, along with a DCED application to receive the monies. Supervisors requested a cost per mile for Armstrong to expand within the township. The Federal money may be used for Broadband, Stormwater, etc.

Supervisors discussed options for Solicitors, they may decide to interview for a new legal firm.

Michael Whitman, Michael Porter and Catherine Wise may attend the PSATS Forum on July 20, 2021.

Road Foreman Report: Drew Francisco reported that the road crew has been continuing the grading and brining roads. The Screen Plant was set up in the Mystic Road gravel pit. Blaine Melnick has a York Rake for sale. Supervisors agreed to purchase the rake for up to \$800.00.

Zoning Officer Tim Pietrasewicz reported that the TV's will be taken to be recycled this week. Two permits were presented. The Rainbow Farm – Property Owner on Old Route 19 will be sent a letter in regard to the on-going violations. The property on Mystic Road with the trailer, cars and fence in the township's right-of-way is being sold. The PA Conservancy sent a survey of their land showing that they do not own the trailer, which needs removed. The Supervisors agreed to pay Tim Pietrasewicz \$20.00 per hour for his work on Clean-up Day.

Correspondence was reviewed.

Michael Whitman motioned to ratify Bills & Payroll for June 3, 2021. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Whitman moved, seconded by Michael Porter, to adjourn the regular meeting at 9:09 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.
