

Chairman Rick Kochel called to order the Earl Township Board of Supervisors meeting, held on **Thursday July 18, 2019**, at 7:00 a.m. The following were present: Supervisors Rick Kochel and Ray Martin. Also present was Lee Zimmerman, Road Master.

Rick made a **motion to approve the New Holland Borough public water extension and to offer connection to specific addresses along Runway Avenue and Windsock Way.** Ray seconded the motion and all voted yes. The extension will provide a loop connection of the existing public water system.

Rick made a **motion to proceed with the Resolution to prohibit Video Gaming Terminals (VGTs) within Earl Township,** Ray seconded the motion and all voted yes.

Ray made a **motion to execute the Storm Water Management and Declaration of Easement for the Allen Newswanger, 351 North Hoover Avenue, Subdivision Plan,** Rick seconded and all voted yes.

Rick made a **motion to execute the Declaration of Easement of Additional Road Right of Way for the Allen Newswanger, 351 North Hoover Avenue, Subdivision Plan,** Ray seconded and all voted yes.

Rick made a **motion to approve advertising the hearing for the Petition to Rezone Land along Hollander Road,** Ray seconded and all voted yes.

Lee reported that the property located in East Earl Township owned by Tony Folker with the driveway onto Redwell Road within Earl Township, is creating a stormwater runoff problem for the roadway. After a discussion, the Supervisors determined we shall work with ELA Group and Technicon Enterprises to send a letter to East Earl Township requesting assistance to remediate the runoff problem.

Lee reported he is applying for a Low Volume Road Grant through the Lancaster County Conservation District, for Snapper Road to replace a stormwater box and pipe to cost approximately Sixty Two Thousand Dollars. The work will require a joint GP3 Permit and creating a new flood plain to keep the water from the roadway.
