

Chairman Rick Kochel called to order the Earl Township Board of Supervisors meeting, held on **Thursday September 19, 2019**, at 7:00 a.m. The following were present: Supervisors Rick Kochel and Ray Martin. Also present was Lee Zimmerman, Road Master.

Lee reported that Rigidply Lumber declined to provide a quote for the salt shed addition. Lee was able to review and change some products being proposed for the project and the new Musselman Lumber quote for lumber is in the amount of Eleven Thousand Eight Hundred Sixteen Dollars (\$11,816.00) and the AB Martin quote for metal is in the amount of Six Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$6,200.00), totaling Eighteen Thousand Sixteen Dollars (\$18,016.00), well under the bid limit of Twenty Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$20,600.00). The Supervisors agreed to proceed with the project.

Lee reported he received a report from LTAP who reviewed and studied the Garden Spot Village (GSV) crosswalk at Linden Drive and South Kinzer Avenue. The markings color doesn't meet Federal Highway Standards and horses will not cross over the markings as installed. Lee didn't approve the markings and a crosswalk should be installed before and after an intersection, not just on one side. Lee recommends that the Township install and maintain all road markings on Township owned roadways. The Supervisors authorized Lee to send a letter to GSV, requiring that the crosswalk area be restored to the previous condition by removing the crosswalk and restoring the roadway. Upon notification that the roadway was restored to the original condition, then the Township will install the proper crossing marks. The Supervisors determined that any Developer proposing a new road design or changes shall be submitted in writing and receive written approval within thirty (30) days.

Ray made a **motion to sign the Reimbursement of Professional Service Agreement for the John Huber, 3353 Division Highway, Major Land Disturbance Plan**, Rick seconded and all voted yes.

Meeting adjourned at 8:45 a.m.
