R. Napikoski called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

J. Sipe made a motion to approve the Minutes of the Monday, January 4, 2021 Re-organizational Meeting. D. Warntz seconded the motion. Motion carried 3 - 0.

J. Sipe made a motion to distribute a COVID-19 Relief Grant in the amount of \$35,000 to FAME EMS. D. Warntz seconded the motion. Motion carried 3 - 0.

J. Sipe made a motion to approve the 2021 Pumper/Hauler License for Brannon's Porta Pot Rentals. D. Warntz seconded the motion. Motion carried 3 - 0.

J. Sipe made a motion to approve the offer of \$100 for Parcel # 16, 22-0147--,000 made at the Unsold Repository Property sale. D. Warntz seconded the motion. Motion carried 3 - 0.

D. Warntz made a motion to approve Invoice # 5 from Bruce & Merrilees, the final retainage of \$32,727.00 for installation of the Traffic Light out of the ARLE Grant. J. Sipe seconded the motion. Motion carried 3 - 0.

D. Warntz made a motion to approve the December bills as presented. J. Sipe seconded the motion. Motion carried 3 - 0.

Keystone Collections Group submitted their EIT, LST & Delinq. Per Capita Tax Year End Report. It noted that even though the COVID-19 pandemic had some impact on collections; the first quarter surplus offset the lower collection rates in the last three quarters. The EIT and LST 2020 collections were both less than 1% lower than the 2019 collections.
