

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING
February 19, 2020

- Call to Order: The Special Meeting of the Greene Township Board of Supervisors, to accept the current Sewage Enforcement Officer, Donald Nicholson's, letter of resignation, to appoint Glen Martin as the new SEO, and to adopt Resolution 20-3 for the new SEO Fee Schedule, held in the Municipal Building on Brink Hill Rd., Greentown, PA was called to order by Chair Gary Carlton at 6:03pm.

 - b. Secretary, Amanda Seagraves, read Donald Nicholson's letter of resignation aloud. Mr Carlton made a motion to accept the resignation. Mr Obert seconded. Voice vote, motion carried.
 - c. The supervisors looked over the fee schedule presented by Glen Martin. Mr Obert made a motion to accept the fee schedule. He then called his motion back and made a motion to appoint Glen Martin as Sewage Enforcement Officer. Mr Carlton seconded. Voice vote, motion carried.
 - d. Mr Obert made a motion to adopt Resolution 20-3 for the new Sewage Fee Schedule. Mr Carlton seconded. Voice vote, motion carried.
 - e. The supervisors discussed the email received regarding the ribbon cutting/grand opening of the Newfoundland Food Pantry on March 13, 2020. All supervisors decided to attend.
- Adjournment: Mr Obert made a motion to adjourn. Mr Carlton seconded. Voice vote, motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 6:16pm.
