

**ORDINANCE NO. 98****An Ordinance Establishing Speed Limits for  
Township Roads T-370, T-372 and T-378**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors for Greene Township, upon receiving public comments of vehicles traveling at excessive speeds, found a need to perform a speed limit study for Township roads T-370, T-372 and T-378; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of Greene Township engaged Shepstone Management Company to conduct a speed limit study for said Township roads; and,

**WHEREAS**, Shepstone Management Company performed said speed limit study, a copy of which is referenced herein; and,

**WHEREAS**, the conclusion and recommendation of said speed limit study is that the safe running speeds on all three (3) Township roads, T-370, T-372 and T-378, is between 19 and 24 miles per hour.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, this 22 day of November, 2019, the Board of Supervisors, pursuant to an advertised hearing, does hereby resolve to adopt the findings of said speed limit study and set a 25 miles per hour maximum speed limit on all three (3) Township roads: T-370, T-372 and T-378, and to post said roads with appropriate speed limit signage.
